Today the car has 98,000 miles on it. The only changes he has made are driving lights, "British" mirrors on the fenders, and Minilite wheels. The car placed 6th in the concours held at Parade in Asheville. Warren also attended Parade in Boston.

RSR Team car in Knoxville for Upgrades

The number 88 997 racecar from RSR (Ranger Sports Racing) was in Knoxville May 18 and 19 for some tuning and upgrades. The car is one of the two cars on the team, which is based in Ft. Lauderdale, FL and competes in the Continental Tire Challenge Series through Grand Am. The Number 88 car is driven by Barry Ellis of Fort Lauderdale and Fraser Wellon of Canada. Mike Grande of Knoxville Performance and Dyno is a partner with the team.

The car is basically a production based 997, not a factory racecar, and runs the stock engine and transmission. This year, Grand Am has allowed the Porsche teams to run 3.8L S engines. Changes are only allowed to the exhaust and intake (before the throttle body). The engine is a sealed unit with no internal modifications allowed. The cars do run Forge Line Wheels with Continental slicks, and of course, Koni suspension.

While in Knoxville, Knoxville Performance changed the exhaust and did some tuning work on their dyno, resulting in 15 additional rear wheel horsepower. The car competes against the BMW M3, Mustang Boss 302R, and the new Camaro. The Porsche is at somewhat of a disadvantage against the other cars as they all run V8's, are rated at more than 400bhp, and the Mustang and Camaro are allowed improved brakes. The Porsche, on the other hand, uses its factory brakes (not even the bigger S brakes!) and the stock 3.8L is rated at 355bhp. The team plans to run the Northeast run of races starting with Lime Rock the weekend of May 28-30th. The race will broadcast on Speed Channel. Check local listing for times.


