A huge, fourteen acre site, allowed Jonathan to lay out a quick, top of second gear event, comprising of an eight pylon chicane, four huge 180 degree sweepers, and two other 'offset gate' sections. Times were plus/minus 50 seconds. Saturdays participants (65 drivers, mind you) had six attempts at the course, whereas Sundays PCA only event had eighteen drivers who got eight tries at the same course, left up over night.
