

A past PCA member, he knows all about autocrossing, and we entered into an agreement to lease his fourteen acre parking lot for autocrossing, during that time of year when they're not open as a huge, family oriented water park. Jonathan Foulds has become our autocross guru (when he and wife Bonne aren't doing DE events...). He

laid out a quick, one lap (65+ seconds) course taking up the entire site! Each participant was allowed six runs. 
