# **Tech Session: Tires & Alignment**

Hunter Alignment System Area Representative, Steve Smith, provided a new look at the high technology of wheel alignment for your Porsche at the February Tech Session at Euro Tech's new shop in Karns. The new technology displays on screen alignment specifications in 3 Dimensions. This shows the technicians what correction needs to be made to get your Porsche back into correct alignment or change your alignment for autocross and track specifications. The manufacturers specifications are derived from the VIN number of the vehicle so it is customized to your car. It is also quick and easy to set the vehicle on the machine to take the readings compared to older technology. The sensors are easy to put on the wheels and are designed so they will not damage the tires and wheels. They measure caster, tow, camber, and driving force alignment with all alignment to the drive center of the car. When the adjustments are made, the screen brings up photos of that car and shows the technician exactly where to make the adjustment points and what tools to use.

He also spent some time talking about tire wear, alignment and how to read the numbers on the side of your tires and how to know what is the right tire for your car. These numbers also tell you the age of the tires. Any tire that is ten years old, no matter what the tread, may not be safe to drive. And that is especially true for high performance cars, Porsche, BMW, Audi, etc. because they put extra stress on the tires. Many members asked specific questions about their cars and several members' cars were used in the demonstration. One important point to leave you with is that you should check the tread on your tires

at least once a month especially on the inside of the wheel, not just what you can see from the outside. Most high performance cars, the alignment is set with some degree of negative camber, which will wear the inside of the tire quicker. It could save you on the highway some day. Thanks to EuroTech and Steve Smith from Hunter Alignment Systems for a great meeting.
