


HEARD 'ROUND the REGION

I NEVER WANTED TO RACE!

"No, Jonathan, I haven't signed up yet for Club Racing. I know you think I should race, but I doubt that I ever will. I bought this race prepared car solely for increasing my safety at track days. I feel much better with the racing seat, harness, and roll cage. Besides, I am having a blast with Drivers Ed. events. After all, I only soloed in DEs a year ago! I NEVER WANTED TO RACE!!"

Although I repeated these words several times each month over the Winter of 2010-11, our Smoky Mountain Region's Chief Instructor never let up. I reluctantly applied for a race license, more to quieten Mr. Foulds than anything. Racing seemed too risky. The rules seemed too

complex and loaded with details I didn't understand. However, the 1987 911 I had bought a year earlier had already been raced by the previous owner in Stock Class F for several years,

so I didn't have to figure out if the existing car modifications were within the rules.

At my first Club Race in March 2011, there seemed to be more details than a person can keep up with even when one's mind isn't preoccupied with the absence of point-bys. In a wise move, the PCA assigns a mentor to help each rookie stay on course with the particulars of logbooks, inspections, meetings, and questions. Jonathan fulfilled the mentoring role with patience and great advice.

That first race was at Road Atlanta. I had previously driven there at three DE weekends. The race stewards had emphasized that our primary goal for our first races was to become accustomed to sharing the track with others without contact incidents. Missteps meant probation, then expulsion for a repeated botches. I was concerned about the lack of point-


bys and passing zones (the long straights) like we had at DE's. Sure enough, during the first lap of the first race, a car pulled alongside me in the Esses! Could I hold myself on track driving off the preferred line? My brand new racing fire suit nearly got stained from the inside! I was pretty much like a deer in headlights the whole weekend. Never wanting to race was sounding to me, like the wiser plan.

At Watkins Glen I was finally getting more comfortable with crazy traffic around me. I figured out some techniques to actually start passing some other cars. This is not as easy as it looks on TV. Those first successes (passes) did it for me. I was hooked! I got so excited that I put some of them on You Tube. Then unfortunately my car started missing

in the second race. At that point I learned that there is a special helpful bond among club racers unlike any I have ever experienced. My competitors flocked to my aid. I was shocked how some fellow racers' trailers looked like small parts stores. Parts and mechanical expertise were given to me while my attempts at compensation were repeatedly refused.

I have discovered that a priority of PCA Club Racing is the for our events to be fun, safe, and clean. PCA Racing promotes sportsmanship and camaraderie within its members. To me, racing is not only what happens on the track. It's about friendships, challenges, and pure enjoyment. Once again, I have learned a life lesson: Never say never.


