

PORSCHE PROFILE: Tommy Wilson

I have been in the Porsche Club since 1993. I started with a 1973 2.0 L 914 which I managed to turn into a street-legal race car. Since that time I have owned a 944, two 911SCs, a 924S and two Boxsters. I started with SMR/PCA autocross events at 411 Speedway and later added driver's ed with some pushing from members Jim and Earline Frazier. It took a couple years but I was later asked to instruct at several tracks around the south.

In December of 2011, I was doing my usual evening cruise of the Internet looking at Porsches for

sale. I do that search just to be doing it. At the time we owned the 2000 Boxster S we drive now and had come to the conclusion that it is such a nice car that I did not want to put it on the track. The last time I put a nice

Boxster on the track there were these little specks on the air dam paint caused by the sand and grit from the track.

I came across this red 924S. This is a car I had never considered owning but a model I had gained some respect for after a couple meetings with one on the track. The "S" model will move right along and handle very well. The 924S has the 944 running gear and the lighter, more aerodynamic body than the 944.

A fellow in Middle Tennessee bought the car and spent considerable money turning it into a track/autocross car. He even painted the entire car. After reading the long list of repairs and improvements, I started to get interested. He actually was asking much less than he had in it.
