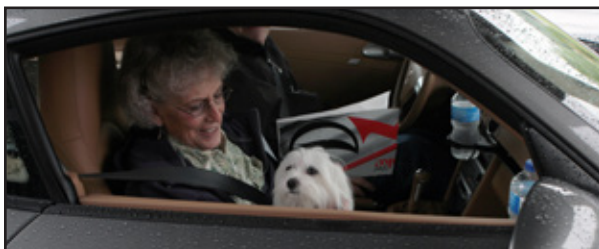

... AND IT RAINED (a Spring Thing 2013 Report)

Spring Thing has been a southeast tradition and a Smoky Mountain Region core event for over thirty years now. A minority of those have been held in wet conditions. Unfortunately, the 2013 edition of the event fell in that 'wet' category. The event organizers knew of the wet nature of the weekend, going in, but what are you going to do? Several adjustments to the weekend were made, and on we went.

The event started at mid-afternoon Friday, as event participants began arriving at the Valley View Lodge in Townsend, TN. The weather on Friday was nice, with no indication that it was soon to turn gray and wet. Our registration area was manned by SMT volunteers, with car numbers, registration packets, and gift bags being handed out. At about 6:00PM, Rich and Carol

Neubauer started preparing a hot dog dinner for all comers. Rich and Carol live in Townsend and were more than eager to pitch in. Thanks guys!

Saturday morning, our own Tom Sullivan provided bagels and breakfast sweets... yumsters! It didn't rain Saturday until fifteen minutes before the concours started. A back-up plan to parking the cars on the grass for inspection was using the Lodge's portico drive through to stage each individual car and have the judges inspect each car as it was presented there. Mike Parker was the chief judge for the weekend, and his handpicked judging crew went to work. About fourteen cars braved the scrutineering, with some very nice examples being shown, including the 'garnet red metallic' 928 of Greg and Lynn Gratkowski, the 996 of Jerry Thompson, and the C2 of our very own Bob Southerland. Results of the concours follow the article.

Immediately following the concours judging, Clyde Peery held a pre-rallye 'school'. The school was held in the same section of the Lodge where registration was the previous evening. As a matter of fact, the entire event revolved around that area. Once the school was complete, lunch was served to the event participants, courtesy of Subway.

Clyde Peery, ably assisted by both Mike Parker and Allan Cox, laid out a TSD rally on the neat roads that surround Townsend. The rally started at the Lodge at 1:00PM Saturday, as the rain

continued. Unfortunately, the rain scared off about half of the scheduled participants, so the remaining twelve participating cars went forward. Clyde had secured multiple checkpoint teams, and they waited for the arrival of the cars. Weather contributed negatively to the outcome, with fewer than half of the entries making the full rally. Results follow the article.

Our banquet Saturday night was packed... not only with event participants, but with great food (thank you Suzan Bowman + Miss Lilly's Catering), and with a whole host of door prizes! Jim Cambron, our Zone Rep, spoke to us about the goings on not only at PCA, but Porsche, also. Looks as though some exciting times are ahead... 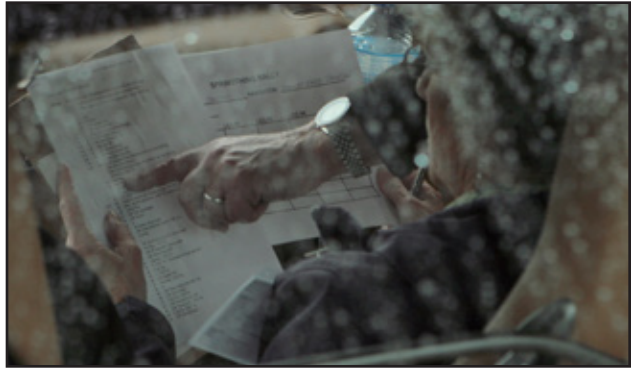

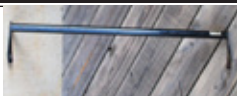
