Our next social is at Restaurant Linderhof on Feb. 9, March 4 is the Great Porsche Showoff at Regal Cinema at Turkey Creek, and March 18 is a concours school. Several very knowledgeable judges will be showing you potential pitfalls in the judging of your car, and more importantly, teaching you how to judge cars as well. 
