

PCA Safety for Autocross Events

In General:

- No passengers except coaches appointed by PCA
- Must sign waiver(s), Participants and Spectators
- Helmets – Current Snell approved
- Walking speeds on site when off course – slow as rapidly as safely permitted after course finish line
- Be alert to surroundings including children and pets. All pets must be on leash.
- Spectator viewing area established.

On course:

- Helmet and seat belt on and secure
- No loose items in car including no hand held cameras.
- Obey starter and all course workers
- Keep car under control. If lose control, foot off of gas and on brake and clutch
- Complete stop if course worker waves red flag. Proceed at slow speed when permitted
- All body parts inside car

Course workers:

- Remain standing on course
- One flagger and one communicator (walkie talkie)
- Never turn back on moving car
- Look to rear of car for cones
- Move quickly to reset downed cones – but do so safely – if can't do safely, wait.

Neighborhood:

- Remember we are guests. Site does not have to let us return. Sites are extremely hard to come by. Sites have been lost due to neighbor's complaints.
- Absolutely no hot rodding off site.
- No excessive speed, squealing tires, loud exhaust etc.
- Violators will be prohibited from competition and asked to leave.
- At the discretion of the PCA SMR President, the violator may be banned from future competition that year.
