SPRING THING 2021 and COVID

To keep us safe, PCA, the Region, and The Carnegie Hotel are working with all our relevant standards and policies. The Carnegie Hotel management team continues to monitor the evolving impact of COVID 19 and are operating the hotel within the guidelines provided by the Center for Disease Control and State of Tennessee. A current Disease Waiver is required and you will be asked questions similar to the SMTPCA Function Health Questionnaire for COVID19 prior to onsite registration.

PORSCHE PARADE 2021 – July 11-18!

Parade registration is on, with the <u>Phase II registration</u> starts April 7th. This year we Parade in French Lick, Indiana, at the French Lick Resort. Parade is always a good time, fun cars, and great people... and it is only 5 hours away!
