PARTING SHOT - Harpers Cars and Coffee



A quarterly favorite on the event calendar is the Harper Auto Square's Cars & Coffee, a Sunday morning "Car Meet" that attracts all makes and models, driven by "regular guys and gals" all the up to serious tuners and restorers. That car you grew up admiring its poster on your wall? It'll be there. The car mom or dad taught you to drive in? Yep, that one too. From rusty "beaters" to show-quality Lambos, a veritable Automotive Smorgasbord.

This year marks the Tenth Anniversary Celebration of Harpers Cars and Coffee, so a spotlight if you will.

In June 2012, Bill Johnson, Chief Marketing Officer at Harper Auto Square (and SMT PCA member) went to his boss, Tom Harper, with the idea of Harper sponsoring a Cars & Coffee Event that could include "car guys" from all over East Tennessee. Tom liked the idea and told Bill to proceed. The site was set at West Town Mall and the date was August 12, 2012. They were hoping for maybe 250 cars. The day dawned beautiful and the event was blessed with a turnout of 414 cars. From that day it has been full speed ahead, each event growing in cars and people. The unbelievable turnouts are now into thousands of cars and the crowd just keeps growing. Keep up with the details on their Facebook page.

Porsche has been at the forefront with numerous guests of honor including Chad McQueen, Porsche racer Lee Keen, Rory Ingram of the Ingram Collection in Durham, North Carolina, the Porsche 919 Hybrid that dominated the 4 Hours of LeMans in the mid teens, and many other classic and historic Porsche racers. Throughout the years Harper has put the Smokey Mountain Region of PCA front and center with a great turnout of members and a widely varied selection of Porsche models.

Harper Auto Square hopes to see this Cars & Coffee Event continue deep into the future and hopes that the Porsche Club will continue to be there as well.
