While the club continues to look for its own autocross location (anybody have a large parking lot or paved area to lend out?), March 5th and 6th opened up the autocross season of East Tennessee Region SCCA at Bristol Motor Speedway. At the beginning of the season, ETSCCA held a "test and tune" on Saturday, March 5th. Unfortunately, it was limited to the first 45 cars to register; however, if you were one of the 45, you were able to run a shorten autocross course. With the smaller group and the shortened course, you were able to run as many times as you would like. This event provided the opportunity to get some of the driving cobwebs out and to assess your car (tire condition, tire pressure, and other mechanical factors). Some of us had over 20 runs! Jamie Parton, Rusty Little, and John McDermott were the club members who participated.

The autocross was held on Sunday, March 6th during a wonderful sunny day – warm enough for shorts! Over 100 cars participated! Patrick (Bo) Whaley (1988 924S), Rusty Little (2000 Boxster), Jamie Parton (2021 Cayman GTS 4.0), and John McDermott (2016 Cayman GTS represented our club. Carl Justice (2013 Carrera 4S, Wilderness Trail Region), Terrence Person (2001 Boxster S, Alaskan Region), David Better (2014 Cayman), and Kevin Wenzel (2015 Cayman GTS, PRO class), all wonderfully represented the Porsche brand! After adjusting times based upon car types (this equalizes the car/time differences) Kevin Wenzel had the fastest time of the day and the third fastest raw time! It was a great time with fun people.

April 5th was the second SCCA event held at Smokies Stadium (bit closer for those west of the 81 split). Another wonderful weather day with 70 cars in attendance and boy were they fun to watch! Fewer Porsches represented; however, they did their best to compete. Bo Whaley was there making hay with his 1988 924S, Jamie Parton took his 2021 Cayman GTS 4.0 to the top of the charts, winning his class and fastest overall time (yes, faster than a few of those corvettes!). John McDermott drove his 2016 Cayman GTS to get his first class win. Mike Detota participated in a 2017 Cayman.

PARTING SHOT – Children's Museum of Oak Ridge (CMOR)

The CMOR is a hands-on museum of history, art, science, and culture for all ages. Since 1973, CMOR has served visitors through innovative exhibits, classes, camps, special events, and outreach programs. The Museum has come a long way–adding exhibits and programs–and is the location of the Manhattan Project National Historical Park's Visitor Contact Desk. Before the Pandemic, CMOR served over 50,000 people a year, numbers are steadily climbing back to pre-Pandemic levels. CMOR receives no government funding except for highly competitive grants. Support comes from a mixed revenue stream including earned income, corporate and individual donations, trusts, and competitive grants.

Why CMOR Matters

• Learning fun...CMOR has 20 exciting exhibits, plus an environmental center and gardens, train caboose, and solar house. Our exhibits are enjoyed by visitors of all ages.

• Diversity and inclusion...for many years, CMOR has offered free admission to its low-income Highland View neighbors, and to developmentally disabled adult groups. Thanks to a recent corporate donation, this program will soon be expanded to include SNAP recipients (regardless of address).

• Protecting our heritage...CMOR's exhibits, and collections preserve and share Oak Ridge and East Tennessee history.

• STEAM for success...CMOR serves children and families with programs – such as our spring, summer, and fall camps - that promote STEAM (that's STEM + Art) and active learning.

What Will the Smokey Mountain Region of the Porsche Club of America's Donation Do?

• Your generous donation will support 10 student scholarships for CMOR's Summer and Fall 2022 Imagination Station camps. A scholarship provides one week of full day camp for a child. • By providing camp scholarships, you are providing an experience to children whose families do not have the means to provide this type of enrichment and who will benefit greatly!


