PARTING SHOT - Pike's Peak Hill Climb and Hoonigans?

With the 2022 Pikes Peak International Hill Climb coming up this June 26, many entries are vying for a win in their class, and some are going for the overall title. One such entry, in a "Porsche" of sorts is THE Hoonigan, Ken Block. If you are not familiar with Mr. Block's Hoonigan Shenanigans, check this out... and this... and this... and this... Let's just say he has "car control" down pat.

Ken's car of choice for the hill climb? Meet the "Hoonipigasus," the creation of <u>Hoonigan Racing Division</u> and <u>BBi Autosports</u>. Like the past BBi Pikes Peak cars, it's a Porsche. Unlike those modified modern cars, this one is a ground-up creation resembling a vintage 911 but it's a mid-engined, AWD car boasting some 1400 horsepower from a 4.0-liter flat-six. Oh, and it weighs just 2200 pounds. And lots of aero to keep it shiny side up and on track.



The "Hoonipigasus" gets its name from the livery and Ken's namesake cars. It's a "Hoonigan" as well as a tribute to the 1971 917/20 known as the "Pink Pig." Ken will be chasing the all-time course record, 7:57.148 set by the all-electric Volkswagen I.D. R, but that is a pretty high bar: Good luck, Ken.
