DID YOU KNOW

Did any of you know that the first vehicle Ferdinand Porsche helped design was an electric front-wheel-drive car? In Austria, Ferry Porsche, at the tender age of 24, and Ludwig Lohner gained a patent for electric wheel hub motors. These were attached directly to the front axles on the



<u>1900 Lohner-Porsche</u>. The original vehicle is on display at the <u>Technisches Museum Wien</u> in Austria.

This is a 1:43 scale resin model by AutoCult, issued in 2016, in a limited edition of 333 examples. You can see the similarity to horse-drawn buggies of the era, though there is a steering wheel instead of a tiller. Considering the weight of those hub motors, steering must have taken a pair of strong arms.



The Lohner–Porsche's design was studied by Boeing and NASA to create the Apollo program's Lunar Roving Vehicle. Many of its design principles were mirrored in the Rover's design. The series hybrid concept underpins many modern railway locomotives, and interest in series hybrid automobiles is growing rapidly.

NEED PARTS?

A collection of Porsche engines, gearboxes, and parts assembled over the past 38 years is up for auction. The collection comprises thousands of components for aircooled Porsche 911 vehicles manufactured from the 1960s through the 1990s and includes approximately 50 engine cases as well as cylinder heads, camshafts, crankshafts, and connecting rods. Also included are gearboxes, fuel injection, brake and suspension, bodywork, and trim pieces. It's a drive to pick it up in Fallbrook, California. Current bid at press time is \$75,000. Do I hear 80? 80? 85?




