PORSCHE PARADE 2024



Registration opens in January, so now it is time to start planning!! Parade 2024 is close by in Birmingham, Alabama, on June 9-15, 2024. Many SMT Region members attend, along with friends from all over. This is great time to see many Porsches, take part in some great

events (autocross at THE NEXT LEVEL!), make new friends, and check out a new area.

"Fueled by Volunteers". All events need volunteers, and if you help at two shifts, on top of a commemorative cheesy T-Shirt you get to attend the Volunteer Party on Saturday, a catered free lunch where they give away all the leftover bling and samples and stuff vendors don't want to lug home.

REGISTRATION: This happens in two phases.

PHASE 1: January 2024, you will register for Parade in general, then upon receipt of payment you will be allowed to secure lodging at the event hotel(s).

PHASE 2: April (generally) 2024, here you will sign up for specific events, tours, classes, competitions, etc. YOU WILL NEED TO PREPARE FOR THIS ONE. Plan your week, have Plan Bs on deck, as well as Plan Cs, maybe Ds. Resolve your time conflicts in advance: some events will exclude others.

Keep tabs on various websites and social media so you can sign up in time: IT FILLS UP FAST. When they say "Registration opens at XX PM" be on the that webpage, ready to click.

PARTING SHOT - Ameila Island Concours & Werks Reunion March 2024

Another Annual National event many Smoky Mountain Region members attend are the PCA's "Werks Reunion Amelia Island" (March 1, 2024) and the "Amelia Island Concours d'Elegance" (February 29 - March 3, 2024). Some trek down for a long weekend, or just for those events, and it is grand time in northeast Florida. Registration for the Concours is already open, and the Werks registration will open Wednesday December 20, 2023 at 12:00 PM (ET).

PCA Werks Reunion: Werks Reunion was created by the Porsche Club of America as an event to celebrate both the Porsche marque as well as the camaraderie of being an enthusiast. There are three levels of entry: Spectator Parking (\$40), Corral Parking by Model (Porsche Only) (\$TBA, usually ~\$75), and Judged Field (Porsche Only) (\$TBA, usually ~\$100). The "Judged Field" is not a contest of who has removed dust from the deepest crevices in their Porsche but rather a judged show that rewards a Porsche that has been lovingly maintained and presents itself well on the field.

<u>PRO TIP</u>: Register for the "Judged Field", you get Rock Star Parking inside the venue, and great spacing between cars. There will be all kinds of vendors, Porsche celebrities, and sights to see at Werks, and a beautiful venue to boot.



Ameila Island Concours: This is one of two of The Majors in Concours d'Elegance, the other being Pebble Beach. All makes, models, and kinds of cars will be there, some rare old classics, an auction, and "vintage dressers" for some of the rare old cars. It is full week of events and galas, but you can pick and choose a la carte. The big public events are the "Cars & Community" on Saturday, March 2nd, 2024, 9:00 AM - 1:00 PM at the The Golf Club of Amelia Island, Amelia Island, FL, and the "The 29th Amelia Concours D'elegance" on March 3rd, 2024, 9:30 AM - 4:30 PM, same venue.

<u>PRO TIP</u>: Register for the "Cars and Community" only, as you will see most of the same cars and vendors, etc., and the Sunday Concours is very packed and can be a zoo. You will miss the "vintage dresser" crowd though.


