#### PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Well, another year is coming to end, but what a year it's been. I wanted to use this month's message to summarize all the events and activities that we've done in 2023.

On the charity front, the Smoky Mountain Region raised a little over \$12,500 from the auction at Spring Thing, driving tour donations, Turkeys in the Trunk and the Fruit of the Vine Raffle. Monies raised went to support Kicko (Knoxville Inner City Kids Outreach), Children's Museum of Oak Ridge and the Kingswood Home for Children in Bean Station, Tennessee. Our goal is to get our contributions as close as possible to those in need. This was also the 7th year for Turkey's in the Trunk and for 7 years, we have collected some 14,750 pounds of food (~7.5 tons) and \$18,725. All food and donations go to the Salvation Army and the Knox Area Rescue Ministries. Clearly, we are helping to make a difference in the lives of those less fortunate.

We also kept the roads hot this year. We conducted 11 driving tours and a gimmick rally. In all, we drove over 1200 miles this year and had 205 cars participate. Destinations and/or drives included a trip to the Lane Motor Museum in Nashville, an overnight trip to Murphy, and various day drives on the Tail of the Dragon, Cherohala Skyway, Hwy 68. Hellbender and many fantastic roads in our surrounding counties. Group sizes ranged from as few as 5 cars to as many as 38.

Our monthly dining socials continue to be a mainstay in the Club. What can I say... we like to eat and socialize! In 2023, we held 12 socials and average 45 to 50 people at each event. We enjoyed pizza at Jaboni's, Blue Tick Tavern and Jay's in Loudon. We enjoyed BBQ at Calhoun's and Italian fare at the Olive Garden. We had two huge get togethers at Eurotech and Harper Porsche. In addition, everyone enjoyed the food and time to socialize at Tellico Village and Cheers at Choto. The Club at Gettysvue topped off our socials with our annual Holiday Party.

Everyone still seems to enjoy our Cars and Coffee events with 22 to 25 cars participating in our informal monthly get togethers to over 50 cars in the PCA corral at Harper's Cars & Coffee events at West Town Mall. These are fun events to have by varying their location, we can keep things fresh. Each event seems to draw a different mix with each area that we visit.

Lastly, after several years of not having a location for autocross events, we are now back in business thanks to the efforts of Rick Berry. We have many new members that have not an opportunity to experience autocross. Having a location again in Knoxville will now provide yet another way to enjoy your P-Car. And we are set for 2024 as well!

As for 2024, we will continue with what works... socials, drives and autocrossing. 2024 will also be our 50th anniversary and what a celebration that will be. Stay tuned!




