Porsche built a 928 convertible prototype in 1987 but it didn't go very far. Prior to this, Carelli Design built a very small run of modified 928 cabrios. AutoCult has made 1/43 scale models of both in resin earlier this year.





There are several differences between the two, most notably that the Carelli is a 2-seater while the prototype has a small rear seat (2+2 arrangement).

And if so inclined, there are a few of the after-market conversions available for sale
