The Porsche 963 (Type 9R0) is an LMDh sports prototype racing car designed by Porsche and built by Multimatic, to compete in the Hypercar and GTP (Grand Touring Prototype) classes. It draws inspiration from the Porsche 956 and Porsche 962 that raced in the 1980s, and first raced at Daytona in 2023. The Penske Team could do no better than 14th, but a year later they won the 24-hour race. This is a Porsche dealer model made by Spark, ask for Part No. WAP0205020RDAY

Motorsports Park after Parade. Although hot that was a blast! See all the fun they had.






















