#### **THE TYPE 754 T7**

In autumn of 1959 work began on what would be the successor to the 356, incorporating a longer length and occasional rear seats. Many design proposals were considered, but eventually the prototype was based on that supported by Ferdinand Alexander "Butzi" Porsche (son of Ferry). The Type 754 T7 debuted in 1960 but was found unsuitable for further development. But various design features, especially the front end, made their way into the 901 prototype, later renamed 911.



This model is by AutoCult, in resin, and only 333 were made this year.
